## 2. How We Use Cookies

- **Analytics Cookies:** Help us understand how visitors interact with the site (e.g. which pages are viewed, time spent). We use tools like **Google Analytics** to improve site content and experience.
- **Functionality Cookies:** Remember your preferences, such as your location or previous choices, to personalise content and enhance usability.
- **Third-party Cookies:** Some third-party services embedded on our website (such as video players, scheduling tools, or social sharing widgets) may also use cookies. We don't control these cookies directly, but we aim to work only with GDPR-compliant partners.

## 3. Managing Cookies

When you first visit our website, you'll be asked to accept or decline non-essential cookies. You can change your cookie preferences at any time through your browser settings.

To disable cookies, you can adjust your browser settings to block some or all cookies. Please note: blocking essential cookies may affect the functionality of the site.
